### FLU SHOTS AVAILABLE

**Steubenville, OH** – Flu shots are now available at the Jefferson County General Health District. Flu season in the United States picks up in October, peaks between December and February, and can last until May, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Jefferson County residents may walk-in at the Steubenville office on Tuesdays from 8am – 4pm, Wednesdays from 10am – 5pm and Fridays from 8am – 3pm. Also, the Toronto office is open for walk-in visits every Monday from 9am – 3pm. If you prefer to schedule your appointment, please call 740-283-8530.

In addition to the main office locations, the Health District will be going mobile throughout the month of October.
