The Jefferson County General Health District Achieves Prestigious KultureCity® Certification, Furthering Commitment to Inclusivity

STEUBENVILLE, OH – The Jefferson County General Health District (JCGHD) proudly announces its achievement of creating sensory-inclusive spaces through KultureCity®, a leading nonprofit organization dedicated to promoting inclusivity and accessibility for individuals with sensory needs. KultureCity's flagship initiative, the Sensory Inclusive™ program, has been widely embraced by venues, stadiums, and cultural institutions across the nation and around the world. This groundbreaking program provides training and resources to staff, enabling them to better accommodate individuals with sensory sensitivities. As a result, countless families and individuals can now experience and enjoy live events, entertainment, and public spaces with greater comfort and ease. The JCGHD is proud to partner with KultureCity® to make all of the JCGHD programs and events sensory inclusive.

The certification process required the staff at the JCGHD be trained by leading medical and neurodivergent professionals on how to recognize clients with sensory needs and how to handle a sensory overload situation. Sensory bags, equipped with noise canceling headphones (provided by Puro Sound Labs), fidget tools, verbal cue cards, and weighted lap pads will also be available to all visitors at the JCGHD who may feel overwhelmed by the environment. The JCGHD is the only KultureCity® certified organization in Jefferson County and the first certified government agency in the entire State of Ohio.

Sensory sensitivities or challenges with sensory regulation are often experienced by individuals with autism, dementia, PTSD and other similar conditions; age is no factor in this. Individuals might become overwhelmed from the crowds, lights, sounds, smells, or other external stimuli at JCGHD. Founded on the belief that every person deserves to fully participate in all aspects of life, KultureCity® has been a driving force in fostering a culture of acceptance. Through innovative programs and partnerships, KultureCity® has successfully broken-down barriers that often prevent individuals with sensory sensitivities from enjoying public spaces and events. With its new certification, the JCGHD is now better prepared to assist guests with sensory sensitivities in having the most comfortable and accommodating experience possible when receiving services or attending any JCGHD event. Funding for the certification and equipment was provided by Encino Energy. The JCGHD is grateful for Encino Energy's commitment to community partnerships.

Prior to receiving services or attending any event, families can download the free KultureCity® App where one can view what sensory features are available and where they can access them. Also, on the App is the Social Story which will provide a preview of what to expect while enjoying an event at the JCGHD.
