STEUBENVILLE, OH – The Jefferson County General Health District (JCGHD) will once again be partnering with Strong Towns Steubenville for Cycle the City in 2025. The JCGHD and Strong Towns are excited to mark the third year for Cycle the City in Steubenville. The JCGHD and Strong Towns both see this monthly event as an opportunity to share in a healthy physical activity, promote active transportation, and grow the bicycle community in Steubenville.

Scheduled for the third Saturday of the month at 9 am from June through October, the route is a riding tour throughout various parts of downtown Steubenville starting at Fort Steuben Park. Cyclists are asked to meet at the Historic Fort Steuben water fountain at 8:50 am. The rides will end at the Saturday Market on 4th Street for fellowship and refreshments with cyclists.

For safety reasons, these rides are not intended for children learning to ride as cycling takes place on main roads. We will have multiple leaders present throughout the group to support riders of all different speeds.
