District Advisory Council Reappoints Dr. Mark Kissinger to Board of Health

STEUBENVILLE, OH – The Jefferson County Board of Health is thrilled to announce that Board Physician Dr. Mark Kissinger was reappointed to a five-year term by the District Advisory Council on Wednesday, March 4. Dr. Kissinger’s new term will run 2026 – 2031. He is currently serving as the Board of Health President until the annual reorganization meeting in April.

The District Advisory Council is comprised of the President of the Board of County Commissioners, the Mayor of each city and village, and the Chairperson of the Board of Township Trustees for each Township. The District Advisory Council is mandated under Ohio Revised Code to meet annually in March with the Health Commissioner for the purpose of appointing a member to the Board of Health; receiving and considering the annual or special reports from the Board of Health; and making recommendations to the Board of Health in regard to matters for the betterment of health and sanitation within the district or for needed legislation.

Pending any changes to the status of current Board of Health members, the next District Advisory Council meeting will be in March 2027.
